Describing school bag items	(indefinite article: <i>ein eine ein</i> )
Numbers 20-69	(question words)
Saying when your birthday is	(ordinal numbers)

#### Die Schule

School subjects and timetable	(giving your opinion)
Telling the time	(12 hour clock)
Talking about what you eat and drink at break	(irregular verb endings)
Describing what you wear to school	(accusative: <i>einen, eine, ein</i> )
School life in German-speaking countries	(understanding a longer text)

### Spring Term

#### Familie und Freunde

Talking about brothers + sisters	(pronouns <i>er /sie</i> )
Talking about pets	(using plural form of nouns)
Giving information about family members	(possessive adjectives <i>mein/dein</i> )
Describing appearance	(adjective agreement with noun)
Talking about people's characteristics	(qualifiers: <i>sehr, ziemlich, nicht</i> )

#### Freizeit

Talking about sports,/free time	(present tense verbs + <i>gern</i> )
Talking about your favourite things	(possessive adjectives <i>sein /ihr</i> )
Saying how often you do things	(writing a letter)
Arranging when to meet	( <i>'möchtest du...?'</i> + infinitive)
Understanding a range of activities	( <i>man kann' ...</i> + infinitive)

### Summer Term

#### Mein Zuhause

Describing your home	(using <i>'es gibt'</i> )
Describing what you do at home	(irregular verbs)
Describing your room	(verb is second idea)
Saying what is in your room	(using prepositions )

#### Stadt und Land

Saying what there is in a town	
Talking about different types of transport	(plural forms)
Asking for and giving directions	( <i>du</i> and <i>Sie</i> )
Buying food and drink	( <i>ich möchte</i> )
Talking about plans for the summer holidays	(the future using the present tense)
