# KEEP MICROPHONE MUTED

Keep your microphone on mute unless I ask you to turn it on to ask or answer a question.



If you are given permission to speak, turn on your microphone to speak but please remember to turn it off again once you have finished.

# CAMERA & MEETING CHAT



Please ensure that you have turned your camera off.



If you need to ask a question, please use the raise your hand icon on the bar when you want to ask a question. Your teacher will see your hand is raised and that you wish to contribute. Please lower your hand (click on same button) when you are done.



Please remember that all students and teachers in the class can see the meeting chat.

# 'LIVE' LESSON BEHAVIOUR



When accessing live lessons, I will follow the rules set out by the teacher which include: How and when to ask a question and how and when to use the video camera.
