### **Peripatetic Music Lessons**



All of this, and it's fun as well! The Music Department at Longsands Academy is pleased to be able to offer a range of peripatetic instrumental lessons in a wide range of musical instruments. We have a team of highly skilled teachers visiting each day and we are proud to say approximately 80 students currently enjoy lessons during the school day. Lessons are on a rotational basis to avoid students missing the same subject each week. You can choose from lots of different instruments, including:

Piano	Violin	Flute	Classical Guitar
Voice	Viola	Clarinet	Electric Guitar
Drum Kit	Cello	Saxophone	Bass Guitar

*And that's not all...* Other instruments can be taught as well, so feel free to contact us if you have a specific instrument in mind that is not listed above that you would like your child to learn. The payment amount and method varies according to the instrumental teacher and whether they are employed by Cambridgeshire Music Service or self-employed and working within the school. The cost would be up to £12 per 20-minute individual lesson depending on the instrument; the exact costs will be discussed when the teacher makes contact with you.
