I am writing to invite you to our Year 13 Information Evening: The Final Furlong, which will take place on Wednesday 2nd April at 6pm in the Library.

The purpose of this Information Evening is to provide information, guidance and support for students and their parents/carers as we embark upon the final 3 months of Year 13 and prepare students for their Advanced Level and BTEC examinations this summer.
